This year, we are studying **The Book of Exodus**, the story of the Israelites discovering their identity and claiming their freedom with God's help. Join us each month to consider a foundational story in our Judeo-Christian history. This ancient story helps us consider important spiritual questions:

What does God want from us?
How does God help us stand in hard times?
How do we honor God in all circumstances?
What do we risk when we "step out in faith?"
